## **RESOLUTION NO. 2016-16**

A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF SHREWSBURY, YORK COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, LEVYING A TAX FOR GENERAL TOWNSHIP PURPOSES AND FIRE PROTECTION ON REAL PROPERTY SUBJECT TO TAXATION FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 2017.

WHEREAS, the Second Class Township Code requires each township of the Second Class annually to prepare and adopt a budget and fix the real estate tax rates for the next year; and

WHEREAS, the Second Class Township Code authorizes the Board of Supervisors by resolution to levy taxes upon all real property within the Township made taxable for Township purposes, as ascertained by the last adjusted valuation for county purposes.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Supervisors of Shrewsbury Township, York County, Pennsylvania and it is hereby resolved as follows:

1. That a tax for general Township purposes be and the same is hereby levied on all real property subject to taxation within Shrewsbury Township for the fiscal year 2017, as follows:

The sum of 0.074 mills, or the sum of .0074 cents on each one hundred (\$100.00) dollars of assessed valuation.

2. That a tax for the specific purpose of fire protection be and the same is hereby levied on all real property subject to taxation within Shrewsbury Township for the fiscal year 2017, as follows:

The sum of 0.34 mills, or the sum of .034 cents on each one hundred (\$100.00) dollars of assessed valuation.
