ORDINANCE NO. 2014 -06

**AN ORDINANCE FIXING THE TAX RATE FOR THE
RENTAL/MAINTENANCE OF FIRE HYDRANTS BY AN EQUAL
ASSESSMENT ON ALL PROPERTY WITHIN SEVEN HUNDRED
EIGHTY (780) FEET OF ANY FIRE HYDRANT IN THE AREA OF
THE TOWNSHIP THEREBY BASED UPON ASSESSMENT FOR
COUNTY TAX PURPOSES.**

WHEREAS, Certain Township properties are provided fire protection through fire hydrants; and,

WHEREAS, The York Water Company and the Glen Rock Water Authority provide the fire hydrants and maintenance thereof, and assess the Township monthly and/or quarterly fire hydrant rental fees; and,

WHEREAS, Section 1802(1) of the Second Class Township Code authorizes the Board of Supervisors to annually assess the cost of fire protection by equal assessment upon all property within seven hundred and eighty (780) feet of any fire hydrant based upon the assessment of property for county tax purposes; and

WHEREAS, Shrewsbury Township Board of Supervisors desire assessing a fire hydrant tax upon the property owners benefiting from fire hydrant protection, and

THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED, and it is hereby enacted and ordained by the Board of Supervisors of Shrewsbury Township, York County, Pennsylvania, under authority of law, that a tax of 0.12 mill, or the sum of .012 cents on each one hundred dollars (\$100) of assessed value, is hereby levied on all property abutting upon said highways, streets, roads, and alleys and upon property within seven hundred and eighty (780) feet of any fire hydrant in the areas of the Township benefited thereby in said Shrewsbury Township based upon the assessment for County tax purposes. Such assessments shall be collected by the township tax collector in accordance with the law of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania.
