

Shrewsbury Township Parks

Shrewsbury Township maintains five (5) developed parks, which provide active and passive recreation opportunities to residents and visitors. The parks are known as **Hametown, Miller, Strawberry Fields, Winchester, and Windy Hill** (John O'Keefe).

The Township is responsible for all grass cutting, trimming, landscaping, tree planting (nearly 2,000 trees planted by the Township), pavilions, playgrounds, trails, and related park amenities. The Southern York County Youth Club (SYC) owns the building located at Windy Hill Park and maintains the baseball fields at that location. The Mason Dixon Soccer League maintains the soccer fields at Miller Park.

With the exception of Miller Park, the land on which the parks and open space are located were granted to the Township by developers. Miller Park was purchased by the Township through grants and Township funds. Development of Miller Park was through grants, Township funds, and a significant monetary contribution by the Miller family; hence the park being named "*Miller Family Memorial Park*"

As reported in earlier editions of the Township newsletter, improvements were made in 2016 at Winchester and Windy Hill Parks through a \$120,000 matching grant awarded by the Pennsylvania Department of Conservation and Natural

Resources (DCNR). There were also improvements made at Hametown through a \$30,000 matching grant received from the York County Commissioners from their ACT 13 (Marcellus Shale) Funds.



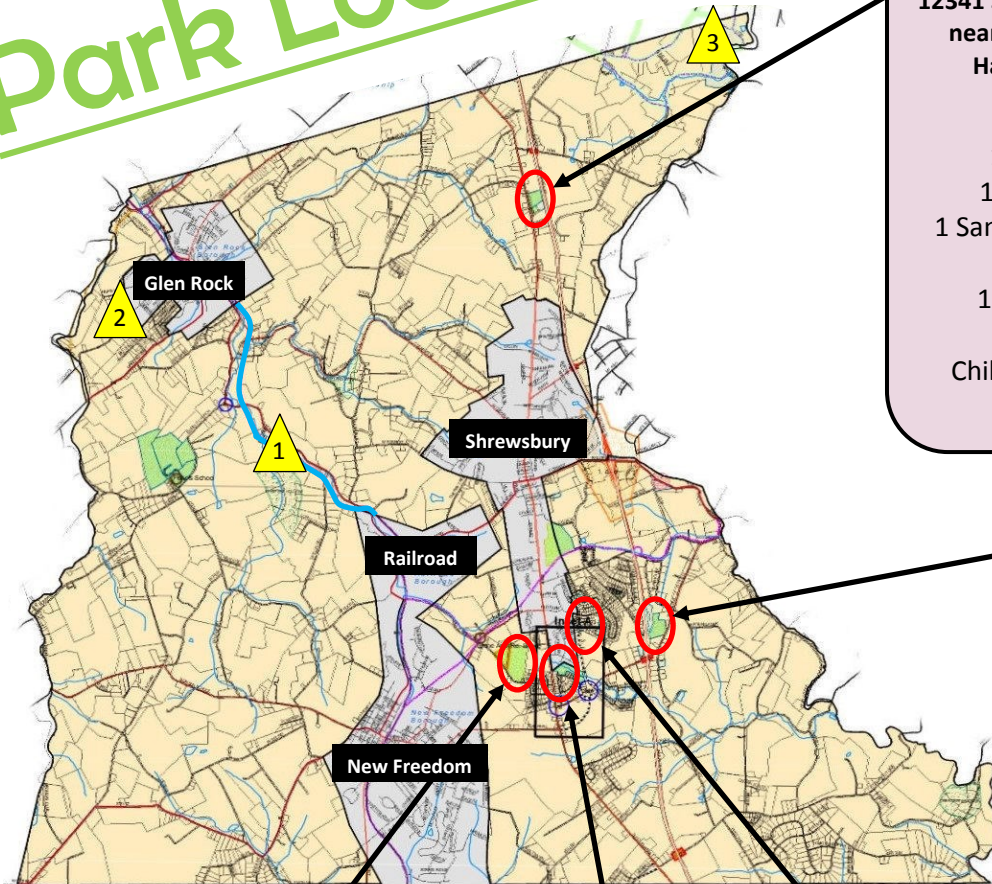
New Playground at Winchester Park
